The Role of the Second Reader DNP Projects

Information:

- 1. The DNP project team will consist of a student, first reader, second reader, and facilitator.
- 2. The purpose of the DNP team is to support the development and implementation of the DNP project.
- 3. The second reader has an important role for maintaining quality and consistency in DNP projects.
- 4. The second reader can be of assistance to the advisor/first reader when working with a struggling student.
- 5. The second reader can be a content expert in the student's area of interest and at the discretion of the advisor, may be someone who is not a nurse.
- 6. The first reader has primary responsibility for the student's project work; the second reader supports the first reader/student and provides additional guidance during key milestones leading to the proposal and the final report

Operational Guidelines:

- 1. The program director, with assistance from program faculty, assigns the second reader.
- 2. There should be an initial conversation/ meeting with the first and second reader and the student to discuss the focus of the project.
- 3. The second reader, along with the first reader approves the proposal and the final paper.
- 4. When reading drafts of the project, the second reader sends the feedback directly to the first reader
- 5. The second reader provides general feedback, identifies gaps, and poses questions. The second reader does not edit the paper unless requested by the project team.
